“BAME” stands for Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic and is defined as 'all ethnic groups except white ethnic groups'. The definition includes Gypsy, Roma and Irish Travelling communities.

It is widely accepted that domestic abuse affects victims in comparable ways, however, we know that those from a minority background, particularly from a migrant community, are disproportionately impacted by domestic abuse.

Freeva have a dedicated Caseworker to support BAME victims of domestic abuse living in Leicestershire.

Our specialist worker will discuss all your support options. We will act as a point of contact to ensure your support needs are met.

We can support you to access safe temporary refuge accommodation, advocate on your behalf with local housing authorities, support access to legal advice including emergency protective orders.
